### Spring 2018 Graduate Research Abroad Scholarship Opportunity

The UCF Intelligence Community Center for Academic Excellence (IC CAE) is happy to announce that we are accepting applications for graduate-level research abroad scholarships for the Fall 2017 semester. The IC CAE is a grant-funded program housed in the Political Science Department here at UCF that seeks to facilitate the professional development of students for future work in intelligence and national security. The IC CAE provides a limited number of scholarships for graduate students interested in careers in these areas.

The IC CAE graduate scholarships are intended for students to conduct field work pertaining to their M.A. thesis or Ph.D. dissertation. Under some circumstances the funds may be used for other research projects, such as papers for a conference or a journal article submission. Research must be related to topics of interest to intelligence and national security, broadly construed. Scholarships are awarded for amounts of *up to* \$8,000 and will be awarded competitively.

Applicants must:

- have a 3.5 graduate GPA or higher
- be a current degree-seeking graduate student at UCF
- register with the UCF Study Abroad Office
- show that they are engaging in research work that is relevant to a future career in intelligence or national security
- be a U.S. citizen

Applicants must provide the following:

- A resume or CV
- A personal statement of no more than 200 words explaining how your study abroad program will enhance your career goals in intelligence and national security
- A research proposal of up to 500 words explaining your research and how it is relevant to intelligence and national security

Students who receive this scholarship must give a short presentation about their experience when they return. They will give their presentation to other students who are associated with the IC CAE and are interested in studying abroad.
