

Peer Advisor Internship

The Psychology Peer Advisors are advanced undergraduate psychology majors who assist other psychology majors/minors to understand and complete their psychology degree requirements. The Peer Advisors inform students of academic policies and procedures, assist in conducting orientation for incoming freshman and transfer students, and provide advisement on other psychology-related matters such as career options and graduate school preparation.

Peer Advisors are trained by the Coordinator of Undergraduate Advising for the Psychology Department, and earn **3 upper level psychology credit hours** in the first semester of the unpaid internship by completing **S/U graded** course: **PSY 3022 Academic Counseling**. This is a **three semester commitment** from *beginning of Fall until end of Summer* and advisors are chosen based on GPA and other extracurricular activities. Must have at least a 3.0 overall and UCF GPA to apply. Must be at least a 2nd semester Sophomore with completion of several UCF Psychology courses. In the first semester of this unpaid internship you will take a 3 credit S/U graded online course called Academic Counseling.

Applications are due May 18th by 4pm, **interviews** will be conducted in the two weeks <u>after</u>. **Training** will be done during summer 2018 semester before beginning of Fall. Availability to meet with Coordinator in Summer when applying, interviewing, and training is <u>required</u>.

Attached is the application to the Psychology Peer Advising Program. For more information, contact the Advising Center. If you have not done so already, it is **highly recommended you sit** with a current PEER Advisor and have your degree audit reviewed, and ask them about the Peer Advising Internship personally.
