

Graduation Checklist

When an Intent to Graduate (ITG) form is received in COS Graduate Services, several academic requirements are confirmed, including the following:

Graduation Check Appointment with COS Graduate Services

All students intending to graduate should schedule an appointment by phone (407-823-6131) or e-mail (cosgrad@mail.ucf.edu).

Program requirements may be more stringent and may include additional requirements not listed below:

• Enrollment in semester of graduation

- o All students should enroll in their final semester
- A waiver of enrollment is granted by the Thesis/Dissertation Editor after completing all requirements, including final upload of document, by the end of add/drop
- o "I" grades must be resolved (no enrollment is required if only resolving an incomplete)
- International students should seek additional advisement from ISC.

Total hours required in program of study have been met

- o Note whether or not waived courses meet total hours requirement (see comments at end of audit)
 - Master's programs must include a minimum of 24 hours of courses

7 year rule

- o Courses used in program of study are not more than 7 years old, with two exceptions:
 - Approved appeal of 7-year rule
 - Doctoral student using courses from completed master's degree

4000-level courses

- o Master's: Limited to 6 hours if 30 hours completed at graduate level
- Doctoral: Not allowed toward degree completion

6000-level courses

- o Master's: ½ of minimum hours required for degree completed at 6000-level or higher
- Doctoral: 36 hours or (if hours waived due to earned master's) half of the program of study completed at 6000-level or higher

Transfer course limits

- o Includes courses taken at UCF or other universities prior to program admission
 - Master's: 9hrs
 - Doctoral: 9hrs or 30hrs (from earned degree hours can be transferred or waived)

Independent Study limits

- o Credit for courses numbered 5907 and 6908 are limited to:
 - Master's: 6hrs
 - Doctoral: 12hrs

Unsatisfactory Grades limits

- A program can include six hours of unsatisfactory grades.
 - Includes "U", and any grade of "C+" or lower (note: grades below "C-" do not receive credit but are counted against GPA)
 - Must have an approved petition to exceed limit
- Graduate Status GPA (at top of degree audit) must be at least 3.000
- Program of Study GPA must be at least 3.000

Graduate petitions are required for any exception to UCF graduate policy.

Thesis & Dissertation Students

- Thesis and dissertation hours cannot be used in a non-thesis program of study
- Enrolled in thesis/dissertation until successful defense (continuous enrollment checked as of FA07)
- o Announcement distributed two week prior to defense; committee approved as announced
- Met format review and defense deadlines
- Completed final signature page (see ETD manual) and met final submission deadline
