Please join us in congratulating Anne L'Huillier, Paul Corkum, and Ferenc Krausz for receiving the 2022 Physics Wolf Prize *"for pioneering and novel work in the fields of ultrafast laser science and attosecond physics and for demonstrating time-resolved imaging of electron motion in atoms, molecules, and solids. [...]"*.

We have extended the deadline for abstract submission to ATTO VIII by one week. The new deadline is Friday, February 18, 2022 at 24:00 (midnight) EST. Acceptance of oral and poster contributions will be communicated in late March, concomitant with the opening of conference registration.

Limited funding is available to support students, postdoctoral fellows, early-career researchers (including assistant professors), members of underrepresented groups in the physical sciences, and researchers at minority-serving and undergraduate institutions.

We expect ATTO to be held in-person. Participants traveling to ATTO from abroad and who do not qualify for a visa waiver may need to apply for a B-1 or B-2 visa from the US Department of State.
