# **Call for Abstracts**

www.icmm2012.us is accepting submissions of abstracts online.

The abstract submission deadline is August 15<sup>th</sup> (June 15<sup>th</sup> if applying for a student fellowship)

**Preparation of abstracts:** The abstract submission site requires uploading a file using a specific Word template which is provided online. **No other files will be accepted.** The document should include the following:

- Title
- Names of all authors participating in the abstract
- Corresponding affiliations (institution and address)
- Abstract body text, Figure/table and References cited
- 1 page limit

**Submission of abstracts:** Once you have your abstract ready according to the guidelines, name the file "Lastname\_institution\_abstract.doc" and submit it by accessing the abstract submission form that can be found at:

All abstracts will be selected for either an oral or poster presentation; you will be prompted for your preference during submission, though we can only accommodate a limited number of requests for oral presentations. Further information about abstract submission can be found at the conference website.

### **Posters Sessions:**

There will be two poster sessions during the conference. Abstracts of the work to be presented should be submitted through the general abstract submission page. Poster dimensions and other details will be provided in the final announcement of the meeting and on the conference website. There will be **poster prizes** for the most significant presentations by students.

### ICMM-2012 Proceedings:

*Elsevier* is a sponsor of ICMM 2012, and results presented at the conference can be submitted for publication in a **2013 special issue of** *Polyhedron*. These contributions will be peer reviewed. Manuscript submission will be handled online by Elsevier. Further information will be posted on the ICMM 2012 website nearer the time of the conference.
