## **Graduate Student Service Awards**

- 1. **out***Reach for the Stars* **Award**: Awarded to a graduate student who has made an effort to bring services or information about Physics (or other STEM fields) to people where those services and/or information are lacking or non-existent. Two awards per academic year.
- 2. **Mentoring Matters Award**: Awarded to a graduate student who has dedicated his/her time to mentor (advise and/or tutor) another student in Physics (or other STEM fields) thus building a relationship that will play an important role in the student's career development. One award per academic year.
- 3. **Above and Beyond Award**: Awarded to a graduate student who has demonstrated actions that go above and beyond the call of duty. The student may have volunteered his/her time in the service of others, be part of an organization that helps and/or represents the graduate student body and/or performed a task in the service of their community. One award per academic year.

## **Eligibility:**

• Open to all Physics graduate students in good standing at the time of nomination and that have not been awarded the same award in the last academic year.

### **Nomination Process:**

- Physics, or Physics affiliated, faculty, administration, staff, graduate and undergraduate students may nominate a Physics Graduate Student for one or more of the Graduate Student Service Awards.
- On March 1<sup>st</sup>, the link to the nomination form will be posted on the Physics website homepage.
- The nomination form must be completed and submitted online by the March 31<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- The nominator must not be related to the nominee.

#### **Selection Process:**

The Physics Academic Program Team and Department Chair will review the

nominations and select the awardees before April 24th.

### **Deadlines:**

- Nominations in March (March 1<sup>st</sup> 31<sup>st</sup>)
- Awardee selection between April 1<sup>st</sup> and April 19<sup>th</sup>
- Awardee announcement before final examination period or by April 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Luncheon one week from announcement (**Note:** A luncheon will not be held this semester. Instead, selected students will receive a monetary award.)
