ICCAE Conference Travel Stipend Application

The Central Florida Intelligence Community Center for Academic Excellence (IC CAE) is a grant-funded program, housed in the School of Politics, Security, and Global Affairs at UCF that facilitates the professional development of students for future work in intelligence and national security. The IC CAE offers funding for students interested in intel careers to travel to academic conferences and present their research. If you have had a research paper accepted to present at a conference on any topic related to intelligence and national security, you are eligible for this award.

Students may apply for awards up to \$1000, depending on expenses. Graduate and undergraduate students of all majors are encouraged to apply, but the student's research topic should reflect interests in areas that are related to a career in intelligence and national security. Applications for this award will be available to submit on a rolling basis. If we close the ability to submit applications, it will be announced on our webpage.

Applicants must:

- be a current degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate student at UCF or Seminole State
- be a U.S. citizen

Applicants must provide the following:

- A completed application
- A resume or CV
- A budget of expected travel expenses
- An abstract of your research paper
- A statement of no more than 200 words regarding how your research relates to your career interests in intelligence or national security
- A letter of acceptance from the conference you will be travelling to

Applicants should be aware that this award may affect their financial assistance status
