Summer 2024 Graduate Research Abroad Scholarship Opportunity

The Intelligence Community Center for Academic Excellence (ICCAE) is accepting applications for graduate-level research/study abroad scholarships for the Summer 2024 semester. This funding is intended to support students who are (1) conducting fieldwork towards a thesis, dissertation, or similar project on topics relevant to intelligence or national security, broadly construed; (2) developing language skills; or (3) receiving training in intelligence/national security-relevant skills at foreign institutions that is unavailable at UCF. Awards of up to \$4000 are available and will be awarded competitively.

The ICCAE is an ODNI-funded program housed in the School of Politics, Security, and International Affairs at UCF that works to facilitate the professional development of students for future work in intelligence and national security.

Applicants must:

- be a current degree-seeking graduate student (masters or PhD) at UCF
- have travel approval from UCF Global
- have an interest in, and eligibility for (including US citizenship), a career with one of the 17 US government intelligence community agencies

Applicants must provide the following:

- A completed application form
- A resume or CV
- A personal statement of no more than 200 words explaining how your study abroad program will enhance your career goals in the intelligence community
- A research/study abroad proposal of up to 500 words explaining your research/study abroad plan and its relevant to intelligence and national security
- A letter of support from a faculty advisor/supervisor

Students who receive this scholarship will provide a written report on their experience and may be asked to give a short oral presentation at an ICCAE-related event after they return.

Applicants should be aware that this award may affect their financial assistance status
