This form must be approved by the graduate coordinator before the PAC meeting can proceed.

- **No earlier than 1 April and not later than 1 May of their first year in the program**, students will assemble and meet with a Preliminary Advisory Committee of no fewer than three full-time Political Science faculty members, all of whom should have Graduate Faculty or Graduate Faculty Scholar status. (see <http://www.graduatecatalog.ucf.edu/GradFaculty/>)
- **Prior to this meeting**, students will present committee members with a written statement of their primary research interests.
- **During this meeting** faculty members provide feedback on the student’s statement of research interests and will identify key literatures that the student will be expected to be familiar with as they pursue their dissertation.
- **Students will not be permitted to take Candidacy Exam C until they have conducted their Preliminary Advisory Committee Meeting.**
