Political Science MA Comprehensive Examination Request Form

- The comprehensive exam is normally scheduled on the sixth Friday of every fall and spring semester. Summer exams are scheduled if needed.
- Students are eligible to take the Comprehensive Exam after successfully completing 18 credit hours of approved graduate coursework, including POS6736 Conduct of Political Inquiry and POS6746 Quantitative Methods in Political Research.
- You must be enrolled in at least one graduate-level course during the semester you take the comprehensive exam.
- To register for the comprehensive exam, return this form to the program assistant no later than close of business on the fourth Friday of the semester you intend to take the exam.
- The exam will take place from 8:30AM - 5:00PM. (Those only re-taking part of the exam will have from 8:30AM - 1:30PM.)
- The exam will be completed on campus, in an assigned UCF lab space.
- Once a student has registered, further details on the exam format will be sent out.
